Will of Thomazine Row 1824 (she died in August 1827)

Thomazin Row's will 3 May 1824 (at the DHC) (looks like a later copy). She died in August 1827.

£100 to Elizabeth, son William £100, daughter Sarah £100, daughter Ann £10, daughter Harriett £10, daughter Jane £100, children of late daughter Mrs Densham £100 shared equally between them. Scarlet cloak to Grace Hooper if still her servant, black silk gown and cloth H??? to daughter Elizabeth, rest of clothes to be divided between children. Daughter Elizabeth to be executrix.

This is the last will and testament of me Thomazine Row of the parish of Sampford Peverell in the county of Devon widow.

First I give and bequeath unto my Elizabeth the sum of one hundred pounds. I give unto my son William the sum of one hundred pounds. I give unto my daughter Sarah one hundred pounds. I give unto my daughter Ann ten pounds. I give unto my daughter Harriett ten pounds. I give unto my daughter Jane one hundred pounds. I give unto Mrs Densham's children one hundred pounds to be equally divided between them and I do order that each and every of the said legacies shall be paid within six months after my death. I give my scarlet cloak to Grace Hooper if she continues my servant at the time of my death and my black silk gown and my cloth shawl to my daughter Elizabeth and the remainder of my clothes to be equally divided between the sole executor of this my last will and testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this third day of May one thousand eight hundred and twenty four.
