Will of William Hellyer the elder 1828

In the name of God Amen I William Hellyer the elder of the parish of Sampford Peverell in the county of Devon stay maker and shopkeeper being of disposed mind and sound memory do make and appoint this my last will and testament. After my funeral expenses and just debts are paid I give unto my son William Hellyer the younger one Bible as published by the British and Foreign Bible Society the like I give unto my son John Hellyer and the like unto my daughter Susanna Knight and the like unto my daughter Sarah Calbreath then the rest residue and remainder of all my effects and estate of whatsoever nature I may possess at the time of my decease I give and bequeath unto my two daughters Mary Hellyer and Jane Hellyer, and I do hereby appoint the aforesaid Mary Hellyer and Jane Hellyer the executrixes of this my last will and testament and I hereby revoke all former wills and testamentary dispositions by me made. In witness hereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this fifth day of April one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight.
